Gang Prevention

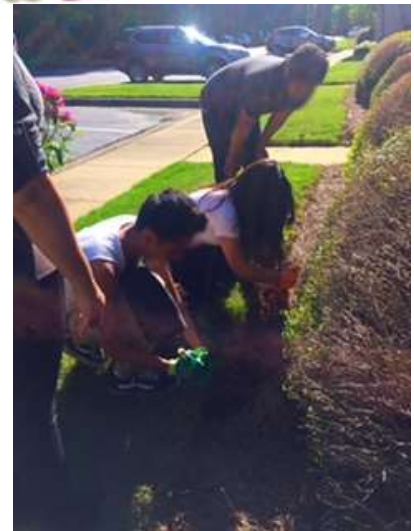
